Speaker Bio

Abstract

Same Language Subtitling (SLS) is a concept of subtitling the dialogue in movies or lyrics movie songs to the same language. In India and many other countries SLS is being implemented as Government's plan to increase language skills.

It is important to measure the effectiveness of this policy as a huge amount of money is being spent for continuing the SLS program. This presentation deals with an appropriate statistical measure and methodology for measuring SLS effectiveness for a particular problem at a minimal sampling cost.
